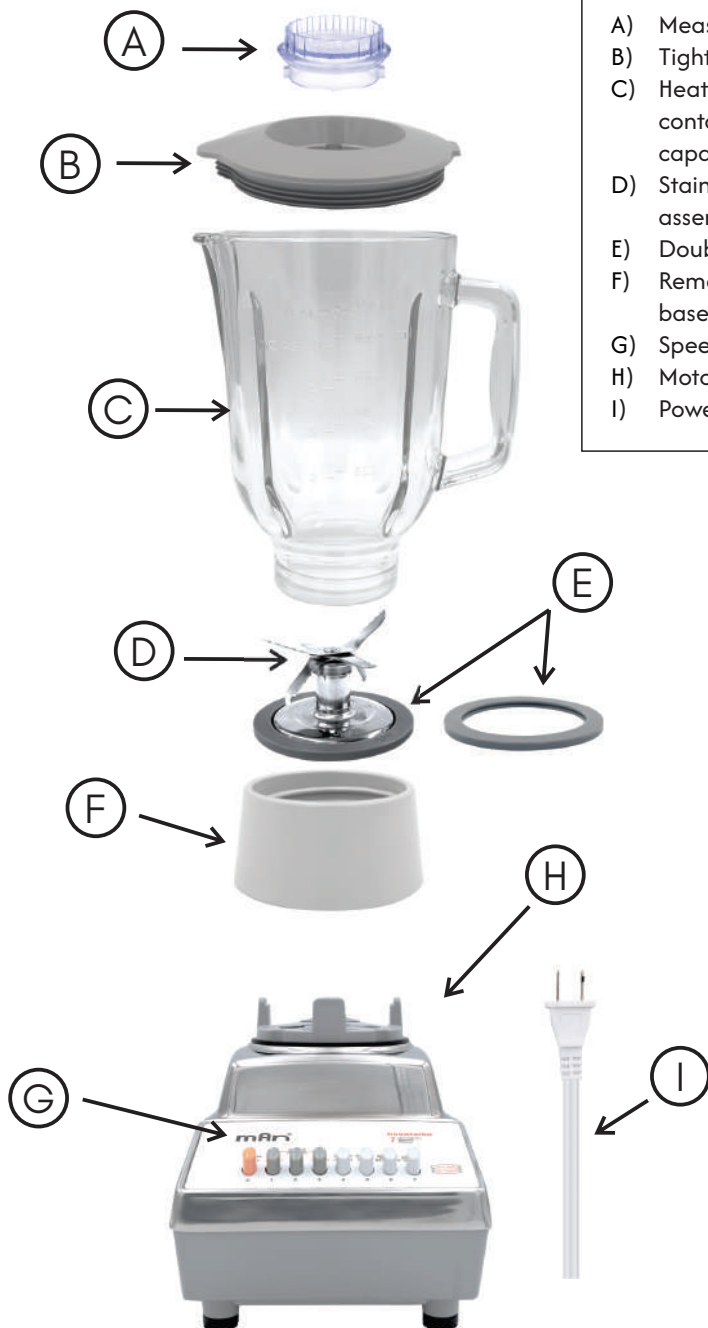

Operating Alerts & Precautions



Before using the blender, read and understand this entire manual.

Misuse can cause accidents; the user is responsible for safe operation.

When using electrical appliances, some basic safety precautions should be taken, including the following and related parts of the blender.



Basic Rules

1. Please read all instructions.
2. Always place the lid on the jar before operating the blender.
3. When blending hot liquids, remove the measuring cap from the lid and keep hands and face away from the opening while the motor is running.

4. Using accessories not recommended or sold by the appliance manufacturer including the jar may create a risk of fire, electric shock, or personal injury.

5. Keep hands and any hard objects out of the jar while the blades are moving. A silicone or rubber spatula may be used only when the motor is turned off.

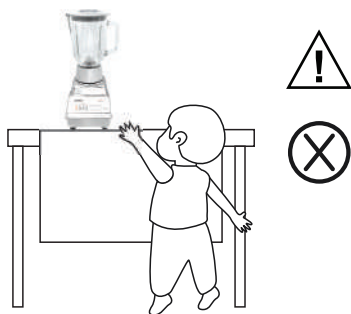

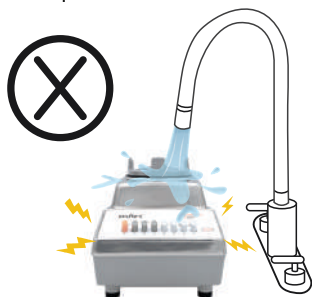


6. The blades are sharp; handle with care.
7. It is important to keep hands away from the motor and the blades while they are moving.

8. Never place the jar base (collar) or the blade assembly on the motor unless they are completely assembled to the jar and lid; exposure to moving blades can cause serious injury.
9. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.



10. This appliance should not be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they are supervised or trained.
11. This appliance is for indoor use only.
12. To avoid the risk of electric shock, do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid.



13. Turn the unit off and unplug it when not in use, before fitting or removing parts, and before cleaning.



14. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord and/or plug, if the appliance malfunctions, or if it has been damaged in any way. Take it to an authorized service center for examination, repair, or adjustment.



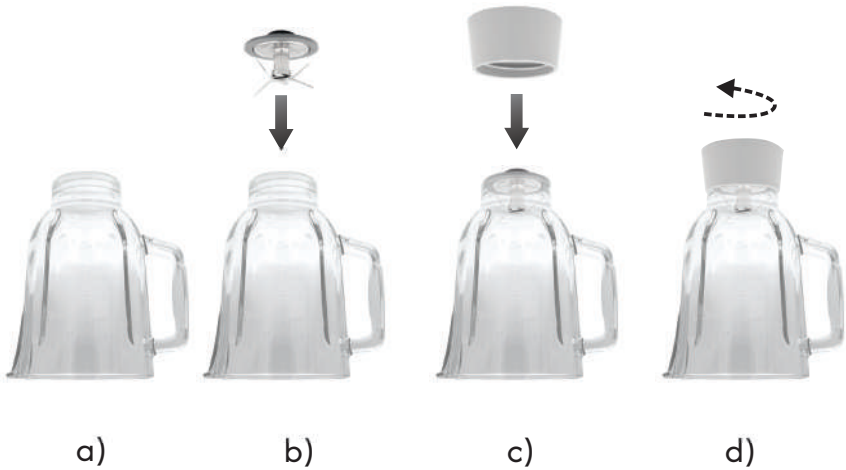
15. Do not carry the unit by the cord or pull on the cord to unplug the blender from the outlet.
16. Do not allow the cord to hang over the edge of a table or countertop or to contact hot surfaces, including the stove. Keep the unit away from the sink and hot surfaces.



Blender Assembly

CAUTION: Follow these important steps to assemble, tighten, and mount the blender quickly and correctly. Injury can occur if moving blades are exposed.

1. Make sure the blender control is in the (0) position.
2. Assemble the jar as follows:
 - a) Place the jar upside down so the smaller opening faces upward.
 - b) Place the blade assembly with the gasket already fitted over the small opening of the jar.
Note: The double-seal gasket covers both sides of the blade assembly; do not place the gasket superficially between the blades and the jar. Make sure it is well seated.
 - c) Place the threaded collar (jar base) over the blades.
 - d) Screw onto the bottom of the jar by turning counter-clockwise to tighten.



3. Verify the jar is completely assembled, then place it on the motor base, ensuring it seats correctly.
4. Place the lid with the measuring cap onto the jar, ensuring it fits the jar shape properly.





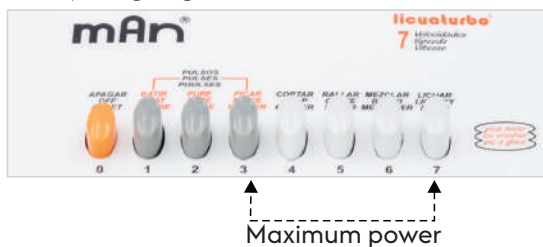
How to Operate the Blender

1. Add ingredients to the jar and place the lid on.
2. Plug the blender into a properly grounded outlet.

IMPORTANT:

- a) For heavy or dry loads (flours, grains, beans, fava beans, chickpeas, crushing ice, etc.) or large volumes, use maximum power. If the load is very heavy or sticky, use a rubber spatula to push the food toward the center of the blades—**always with the motor off**.

- b) For soft or light loads (liquids, mixing milks, juices, etc.) or small volumes, use the different speeds. If the blender seems slow or the load is not moving, switch to maximum power or reduce the quantity.
- c) We recommend placing your hand on the lid at the start of blending to prevent spills.
- d) If you need to add ingredients while running, remove only the measuring cap and add through that opening. If liquids are hot, keep face and hands away and do not fill the jar beyond one-third of its capacity.



3. Turn the blender off and remove the jar only after the motor has come to a complete stop.
4. Unplug the blender by pulling on the plug—**do not pull on the power cord**.



Cleaning the Blender

1. Unscrew the jar by turning clockwise (the marking on the collar indicates the direction to tighten; to loosen, turn in the opposite direction).
2. Remove the collar and blade assembly with a cloth (blades are sharp), as well as the gasket that goes around the base of the blade assembly.
3. Wash the blade assembly, jar collar, gasket, jar, lid, and measuring cap—preferably in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry all parts completely.
4. If your jar is glass it may be washed in a dishwasher; if it is plastic, use a soft sponge.
5. Your blade assembly includes a double-seal gasket. After washing, verify it has been correctly placed around the base of the blade assembly as shown in the picture. We recommend not washing the blade assembly in a dishwasher.
6. Do not use abrasive pads on plastic parts; use only soft sponges.
7. Do not wet the motor base. Clean it with a damp cloth and dry completely.
8. If liquids spill on the motor base, wipe with a damp cloth and dry completely.

Maintenance

The motor in your blender is permanently lubricated and does not require additional lubrication. Depending on usage, periodically check the condition of the double-seal gasket; if a replacement is needed, visit your nearest service center. Repairs must be performed by an authorized service center and qualified personnel.

IMPORTANT:

Do not attempt to sharpen the blade assembly. It is permanently sharpened for normal use. If you need to replace it, visit an authorized service center to purchase a new one.



Speed Selection

The available speeds help you choose the power and degree of mixing, chopping, or blending required for your ingredients. Each button is clearly labeled. The following table is a suggestion feel free to adjust to taste.

7 Speeds	Description
1-3	Pulse: Ideal for chopping nuts, almonds, hazelnuts, peanuts, etc., where a coarse chop is needed, and for chopping meat. Determine the texture you want and adjust the time and speed accordingly. The 4 pulse settings are ideal for texture in sauces or chopped foods. We recommend pulsing 2–10 seconds at intervals.
3	To prepare cooking recipes and salad dressings.
5	For salsas of all kinds, including pico de gallo. This speed will not leave foam in sauces.
6	Grind sugar to obtain powdered (confectioners') sugar for baking.
7	For whipped creams, cream soups; excellent for blending fruits, vegetables, and making mayonnaise.
7	Maximum power: suitable for milling hard or semi-hard grains like beans, fava beans, chickpeas, coffee, etc. Ideal for making frappe ice; drop cubes one by one quickly through the measuring cap opening.

The usage time of your blender is determined by you, the type of blending you are doing, and the times indicated in each recipe.

SUGGESTION	APPROXIMATE TIME
Mayonnaise:	2 minutes.
Peanut butter:	2½–3 minutes.
Dressings:	12 seconds.
Creams:	1 minute.
Sauces:	5 seconds (with texture) / 4 to 10 seconds (fully blended).
Mix powdered milks:	10 to 15 seconds.
Mix pancake ingredients:	2 minutes.
Fruit smoothies/shakes:	5 to 30 seconds.
Cocktails:	5 to 8 seconds.

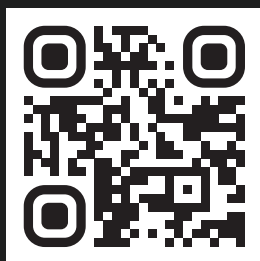
